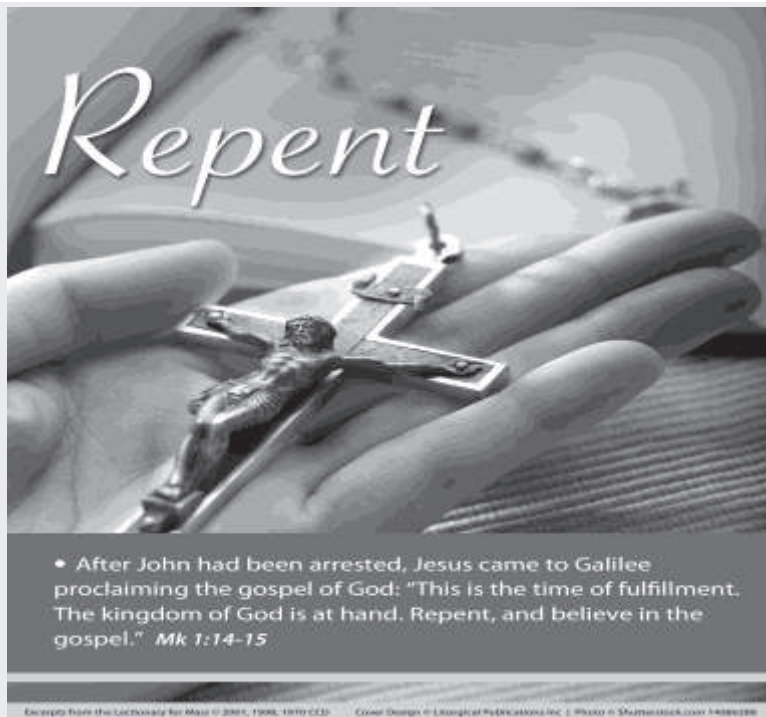

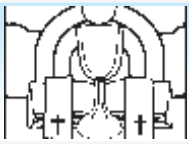

February 26, 2012 First Sunday of Lent



PASTOR'S POTPOURRI — – FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Throughout the land, catechumens and candidates will be traveling to their local cathedrals for the Rite of Election. This is the rite in which those approaching the waters of rebirth to be baptized, confirmed and make their first communion...along with those coming from other faiths who have already been baptized but need to make a profession of faith in the Catholic Church, be confirmed and make their first communion....will meet the bishop and be welcomed/elected into the church. It is a wonderful and meaningful ceremony...long-remembered by those who participate.

On this first Sunday of Lent 2012...we experience again the covenant God made with Noah and Jesus' time in the desert. Interestingly, we are told in Mark that "the Spirit DROVE Jesus out into the desert..." He didn't LEAD Him or GUIDE Him...but DROVE Him into the desert. For forty days he contended with the Evil One and came out victorious, going from there to Galilee to begin His public ministry.

The bare-bones Gospel clearly demonstrates why Mark is the most economical storyteller among the four evangelists. In contrast to the saying "less is more", today less is actually less. We don't hear the details that we hear in Matthew and Luke about the dramatic clash of personalities between Jesus and Satan. Mark simply states that episode of 40 Days and Nights as "tempted by Satan".

As we celebrate the Lenten springtime, maybe today is a good day to see where the Spirit is DRIVING us...inviting us to become more deeply committed to the Lord and those around us. And, may we have confidence that the Lord is with us on the journey from Ashes to Easter... **MSGR. BOB**

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT Here's a question: When exactly did the gates of heaven open? Was it at the moment of the crucifixion (see Mt. 27: 52-53)? And where exactly did the spirit of Jesus go when his body lay in the "abode of death?"

The second reading today (I Peter 3: 18-22) suggests a tantalizing answer: *In (the Spirit) he also went to preach to the spirits in prison, who had once been disobedient while God patiently waited in the days of Noah...* This enigmatic sentence became a scriptural basis for the section in the Apostles' Creed that states "He descended into hell".

scended into hell".

We used to say that every Sunday, but what does it mean? I love this portion of an ancient poem by an unknown Christian, speaking about this mystery:

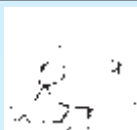
The earth trembled and is still because God has fallen asleep in the flesh and has raised up all who have slept ever since the world began. God has died in the flesh and hell trembles with fear. He has gone to search for our first parents, gone to free from sorrow the captives Adam and Eve. He took them by the hand and raised them up, saying: "Awake, O sleeper, and rise from the dead, and Christ will give you light". How does time and space work with God? Had "all who had ever slept since the world began" waited out those thousands of years in "real time"? Or is there perhaps a "wrinkle in time", a mere blink that separates this life (and death) from eternity?

Be at peace. The God of heaven and earth (and under the earth) has gone in search of us. *Is it hard to imagine that hell might be empty?* **Kathy McGovern c. 2012**

MENSAJE DEL PAPA BENEDICTO XVI PARA LA CUARESMA 2012

**"FIJÉMONOS LOS UNOS EN LOS OTROS PARA
ESTÍMULO DE LA CARIDAD Y LAS BUENAS
(HB 10, 24)**



Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

La Cuaresma nos ofrece una vez más la oportunidad de reflexionar sobre el corazón de la vida cristiana: la caridad. En efecto, este es un tiempo propicio para que, con la ayuda de la Palabra de Dios y de los Sacramentos, renovemos nuestro camino de fe, tanto personal como comunitario. Se trata de un itinerario marcado por la oración y el compartir, por el silencio y el ayuno, en espera de vivir la alegría pascual.

Este año deseo proponer algunas reflexiones a la luz de un breve texto bíblico tomado de la Carta a los Hebreos: "Fijémonos los unos en los otros para estímulo de la caridad y las buenas obras" (10,24). Esta frase forma parte de una perícopa en la que el escritor sagrado exhorta a confiaren Jesucristo como sumo sacerdote, que nos obtuvo el perdón y el acceso a Dios. El fruto de acoger a Cristo es una vida que se despliega según las tres virtudes teologales: se trata de acercarse al Señor "con corazón sincero y llenos de fe" (v. 22), de mantenernos firmes "en la esperanza que profesamos" (v. 23), con una atención constante para realizar junto con los hermanos "la caridad y las buenas obras" (v. 24). Asimismo, se afirma que para sostener esta conducta evangélica es importante participar en los encuentros litúrgicos y de oración de la comunidad, mirando a la meta escatológica: la comunión plena en Dios (v. 25). Me detengo en el versículo 24, que, en pocas palabras, ofrece una enseñanza preciosa y siempre actual sobre tres aspectos de la vida cristiana: la atención al otro, la reciprocidad y la santidad personal... Continuara...

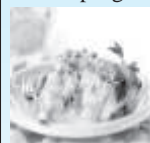

REFLEXION DEL EVANGELIO DE HOY

GÉNESIS 9:8-15. En esta lectura del Génesis, el primer libro de la Biblia, leemos la historia de Noé y el arca. Noé, su familia y las parejas de criaturas vivas, que estaban en el arca y sobrevivieron al gran diluvio que inundó la tierra. Finalmente salieron del arca al suelo seco. Entonces Dios puso un hermoso arco iris en el cielo como señal de la alianza entre Dios y su pueblo.

Dios promete que nunca un diluvio destruirá "a los hombres y animales". Como un anillo de boda, un arco iris es una señal de amor fiel.

1 PEDRO 3:18-22. Esta carta fue escrita para animar a los primeros cristianos a ser fieles a Cristo, quien nos lleva a Dios. El escritor recuerda la historia de Noé, y su familia, quien se salvó del diluvio en un arca. Ellos navegaron por las aguas a una nueva vida. "Y aquella agua representaba el agua del bautismo, por medio del cual somos ahora salvados", explica la carta.

En el Bautismo el agua es signo de vida por medio de la resurrección de Jesucristo. El murió por nuestros pecados y conquistó la muerte para que pudiéramos gozar de vida eterna.

MARCOS 1:12-15. ¿Puedes imaginar una escena de una película ilustrando la primera parte de la historia del evangelio de hoy? Jesús está en el desierto donde fue tentado por Satanás. También está rodeado de bestias salvajes y ángeles. Debieron ser 40 días muy interesantes, los que pasó Jesús preparándose para ir a predicar la buena nueva. "El reino de Dios está cerca", anunció en Galilea y llamó al pueblo a prepararse para el reino de Dios a reformar sus vidas.

La Cuaresma puede ser como un nuevo día para nosotros, lo mismo que fue para Noé y su familia cuando terminó el diluvio. Es tiempo para un nuevo inicio y renovación de nuestra alianza de vivir como pueblo de Dios.
