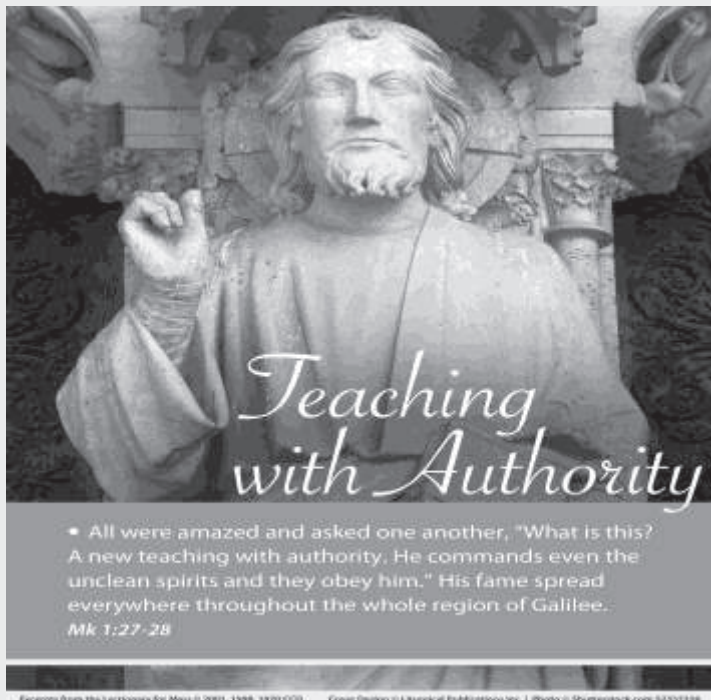

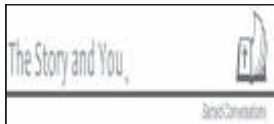


PASTOR'S POTPOURRI – RECOGNIZING THE LORD

In the Gospel today we meet a man with an unclean spirit. He makes an outburst at the synagogue in Capernaum, just as Jesus has concluded his preaching. We seldom encounter this kind of behavior in modern world, but if we did, we might decide that the person was suffering from schizophrenia. The man in the Gospel appears to be deluded, thinking that Jesus has come to destroy him. Just as Jesus cured the physical conditions of cripples, lepers and the blind, he cures the mental illness of this man. He order the evil spirit to come out of the man...Jesus stands against evil and restores this particular man to health.

Here is something to note. In Mark's Gospel, the people who have "unclean spirits" recognize Jesus for who he is. Ironically, many of those who witnessed Jesus' actions, including those closest to him (his disciples) did not recognize him or acclaim him for who he was. But the demons are aware: "I know who you are...the Holy One of God."

This day, let us recognize the Lord in our midst...in the gathered community who sings and prays, in the priest who acts in the person of Christ, in the Word – His Word – proclaimed to us, in the reserved Sacrament, in the tabernacle. Our ability to recognize these multiple presences of Christ, then remind us that the mystery is this...Christ also lives in you and lives in me. Thanks be to God. Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time

St. Paul's remarks today about the differences between those who are married and unmarried calls to mind the beautiful death last November of Sr. Antonia Anthony, OSF. She was killed by a young driver who ran a red light four blocks from her home.

In her last moments Sr. Antonia prayed Come, Lord Jesus. And he did.

Sister Patty Podhaisky gave this account: Within minutes Sr. Antonia relaxed, and her breathing slowed down until she peacefully breathed her last, surrounded by her Franciscan sisters and her family. We felt deep communion in the Heart of God with all of you, her/our sisters, families, friends, companions, as we journeyed with her into the heart of Great Love. It seemed as though Antonia was running home, and the breeze of her passing brushed each of us with tender grace.

I think St. Paul would take especially take note of the "deep communion" that the Sisters, and her family, all felt with the Body of Christ throughout the world who had known and loved and been loved by Sr. Antonia, whose passion for justice had propelled her to the poorest places on the globe.

The Marycrest Franciscans appeared in court two months later to appeal for mercy for the young man. They gave him a picture of Sr. Antonia, and a prayer card from her funeral. Instead of prison he will perform five hundred hours of community service. Sr. Antonia's spirit remains. We, all of us, are one Body. And we do not live or die alone. Married and unmarried, ordained and vowed Religious, we journey together, praying *Come, Lord Jesus*. And there he is, in the midst of us. **Kathy McGovern**
