## PASTOR'S POTPOURRI – COMMITMENT WEEKEND AND CHRIST THE KING

This weekend marks the closure of this Year of Grace. We say goodbye to the Gospel of Matthew and look forward next week to the Season of Advent and the Gospel of Mark. It is also the weekend when we will begin to use the new Roman Missal and the changes that it brings in our responses and understanding of celebrating the liturgy. We will have a card for you to use with these new responses until we have it down. For those who are old enough to remember (1963) when we moved from Latin to the vernacular in our liturgy, one week the priest was praying the Mass with his back to the people...the next week, he was facing the people. It was difficult for all to move into a new mode of operation. But for the past nearly 50 years, we have experienced one way of praying together. Now, we being a new way, and the change will catch some off guard and others will struggle and some will not like it all. That is because change is always difficult. But the Spirit calls us at this time to experience the beauty and the formality of the English language that will, hopefully, help all of us to pray better together and to rejoice in the gifts we have received as God's people at prayer.

On another note, just a reminder that the Mass time on Sunday mornings at St. Clare has changed. Beginning the First Sunday of Advent, next Sunday the 27<sup>th</sup>, the Mass will begin at 8:30 instead of 8:00 A.M. Please let your friends and relatives know, who may not be aware of this change.

**COMMITMENT SUNDAY...TODAY** each of us is invited to renew our Stewardship of Treasure. We will fill out a commitment card and bring it to the altar as an expression of the sacrifice we are making as we return to the Lord and His Church, a portion of the treasure He has first given to us. It is a THANK OFFERING...which responds to the Psalmist who prays: "What return can I make to the Lord for the good He has given me..." Stewardship is a word that helps us to understand that we really don't "own" anything. Everything belongs to God. He entrusts us with time, talent and treasure so that we may use His gifts for the building up of the Body of Christ and the Kingdom. Our life, our family, our education, our job, our opportunities, our talents and skills...all is gift. And so the Lord invites us with the Biblical principal to TITHE... a tithe is a 10<sup>th</sup> part of what we have...and that is returned for the work of the Church along with other charities in order that we may not come to the altar with empty hands, but may truly make a sacrifice to the Lord.

When we bring the gifts of bread and wine to the altar, the collection is also brought forward and placed near the altar. This is not a coincidence. It is symbolic that our money expresses our lives. And we offer our lives to be transformed more fully into being children of God. Just as bread and wine are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ, so we, too are transformed. I have said before, and I say it again...if you step out in faith and give 10% of your income to the work of the Church and other charities of your choice, and find that at this time next year you are worse off financially than you are right now, I will refund whatever you have given. I have been preaching about tithing as a way of life for nearly 40 years. In that time, no one who has put their trust in God to handle their finances has ever asked for one penny back. The reason? God is faithful and will never let us outdo Him in generosity. I hope that you are pleased by the commitment you make today. Thank you for stepping out in faith and taking the Lord's promises to heart...ultimately...when I was hungry, you gave me to eat, when thirsty...etc. Come, and inherit the kingdom which has been prepared for you from the foundation of the world. With gratitude and faith, we respond to the Lord's invitation to make us more Christian. For that is what stewardship of treasure and proportionate giving are all about. Not about raising money...but raising Christians. God bless us everyone!

And so the year ends as it began. Last Advent we began this year of Matthew by reading the account of the angel who appeared to St. Joseph in a dream, telling him that Mary had conceived a child through the Holy Spirit. And this was to fulfill what the prophet Isaiah had spoken, that a virgin would conceive and bear a son, whose name would be Emmanuel, which means *God with us*.

And all year long Matthew told memories of Jesus that brought that truth home over and over again. The poor in spirit, the peacemakers, those who mourn—God is with them! Those who ask, and seek, and knock—God is with them! Fishermen, and Canaanite women, and tax collectors who leave it all behind to follow Jesus—God is with them! And even workers who come to the fields very late in day come to know that God is with them too.

And now, at the Final Judgment, the greatest of all secrets is revealed: He is not only *with us*, but He has *become us*. Through his Incarnation in us he has actually become one with us. He has so embedded Himself with us that when others see us in our brokenness they are looking at Christ Himself.

*Lord, when did we see You? When we were sick and found comfort, unemployed and found work, at a dead end and found the way out, was that You? Ah. So it was You all along, healing us through Your Body on earth and in heaven.
