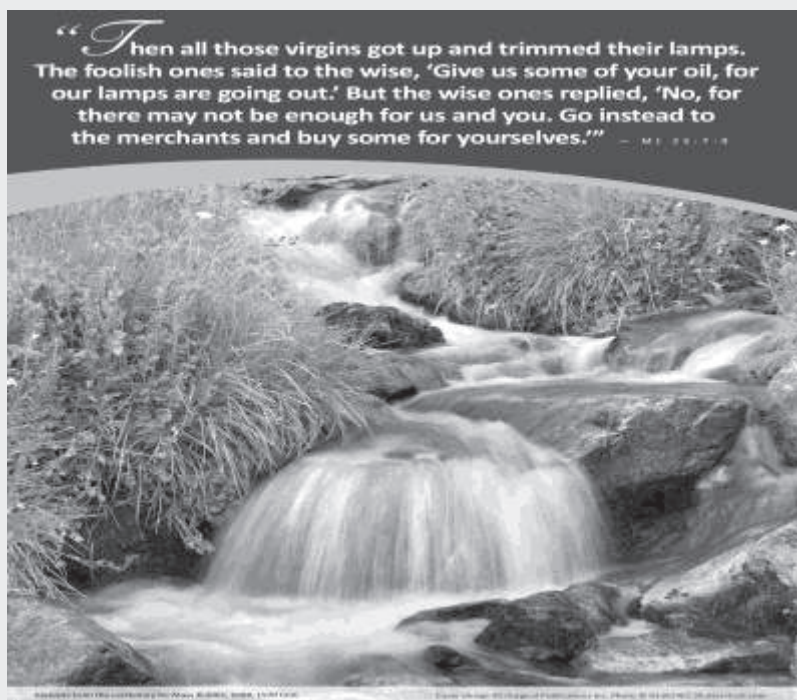

PASTOR POTPOURRI — MAY THE SOULS OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED THROUGH THE MERCY OF GOD, REST IN PEACE.

This age-old prayer is still used in the liturgy for vigils and funerals. It is a good prayer, and expresses our hope for those who have gone before us to the other side of life. During the month of November each year, the Church calls us to remember our faithful dead. One of the ways we do that in the valley is through the Book of the Dead. At each location, St. Mary's, St. Clare's and Beaver Creek, there is a purple book in which you can write the names of your departed. If you have placed their names already, they are still there from year's past. If someone who was dear to you died during the past year, you may enter their names, all of whom will be remembered at the Masses celebrated during the month of November.

St. Paul urges us to console one another with words of faith as he writes to the Thessalonians. He reminds us about those who have fallen asleep, that we not grieve as those who have no hope. We grieve but with an understanding expressed in the Creed, that we believe in the resurrection of the body and life-everlasting. Because Jesus died and rose again, we have hope that He will bring with Him all who have died with the sure and certain hope of resurrection.

Today we welcome seminarians from our two seminaries in Denver, St. John Vianney and Redemptoris Mater. This is the time for our annual appeal to support the seminary and all of our seminarians. Thirty-Second Sunday



We're coming near to the end of the liturgical year, and boy can we feel it. Paul warns about trumpets sounding and God's voice resounding through archangels. And then of course we have this parable of the ten virgins, all anxious for the (late) Bridegroom, but only five are prepared for His coming. Yes, the end-of-the-world readings are screaming for our attention.

But I want to recall a scene in *The Hiding Place*, one of the most powerful books written about those who lived and died during the Holocaust. Corrie ten Boom, her sister and their father had been hiding terrified Jews in a secret upstairs closet in Corrie's room in Amsterdam. Corrie, organized and thoughtful, had prepared a bag for herself, with aspirin, a change of clothes, and some small crackers to comfort her when she inevitably fell into the hands of the Nazis and was taken off to the camps.

But the night that the (always punctual) Germans showed up at her house, screaming and pounding and demanding entrance, those who were being hidden leapt into the secret room while Corrie threw her bag in front of the closet.

And when they dragged her away, already feverish with influenza, she left her bag behind. She couldn't take the chance that an errant piece of clothing was hanging outside the closet, a clue that would have ended in death for all who had sought safety with her.

And she saved them all. How? By heroically sacrificing her own preparation for those who could never prepare. And I'll bet that, at the moment of her death decades later, the Bridegroom took her straight away into the Wedding Feast.

In what ways have you prepared to meet the Bridegroom?

SABIDURIA 6:12-16. Varios escritos de las escrituras hebreas son llamados libros de "sabiduría" porque nos ayudan a pensar y a entender la larga búsqueda de la sabiduría que ha tenido la humanidad. La sabiduría es el don dado por Dios para saber y hacer lo que es correcto. La lectura de hoy presenta a la sabiduría como una mujer, espléndida y material. La sabiduría está dispuesta a aparecer a los que se mantienen "vigilantes". La sabiduría viene a los que la buscan en la escritura, la oración y una vida centrada en Dios. Una persona sabia trata de tomar las mejores decisiones en su vida.

1 TESALONICENSES 4:13-18 O 4:13-14. Una de las experiencias más difícil que se puede vivir en la vida es la muerte de un ser querido. Pablo entendió esto muy bien y aseguró a los tesalonicenses que sus seres queridos muertos, en Cristo resucitarían de nuevo. ¿Cómo puede esta carta de Pablo ser una fuente de esperanza para tí?

Mateo 25:1-13. ¿Por qué necesitamos el don de la sabiduría? ¿Por qué necesitamos estar preparados para la venida de Jesús? La parábola de hoy nos ofrece algunas respuestas. Cinco novias necias, cuyas lámparas no tenían suficiente aceite, iban a encontrarse con el novio (el novio en esta historia representa a Cristo). A media noche, cuando el novio llega, el aceite de las lámparas de las novias necias se había agotado y corren en dirección opuesta a comprar más. Pero al regresar, la puerta donde se celebraba la boda estaba cerrada y el novio les dijo "yo no las conozco".
