PASTOR'S POTPOURRI – BEING FAITHFUL STEWARDS

The Gospel according to Matthew is rich in its desire to help us understand the mind and heart of the Lord Jesus. The parable we hear today reminds us of a couple of things....(1) That the Lord will come again, and will expect to have a return on the gifts He has given; and (2) Each of us is a steward of God's manifold gifts.

Last weekend we heard the parable of the Ten Bridesmaids...five foolish and five wise. The call was to be vigilant and prepared and living in hope, because we know and believe that the Lord will come again, though we know not the day nor the hour. So, we are to stay awake. Next weekend, we conclude the liturgical year with the 25th Chapter of Matthew, the Final Judgment...the Lord invites us..."come blessed by my Father and inherit the kingdom which has been prepared for you from the foundation of the world...for when I was hungry, you gave me to eat, etc. ... as long as you did it for one of least brothers or sisters – you did it for me."

Today, we are stewards entrusted with what belongs to another. Ultimately, everything we have, and are, and hope to be – comes from the Lord. We are allotted a certain amount of time, talent and treasure...for ourselves but also to share with others. We don't really own anything...all is gift. We will be judged on how well we use the gifts God has given for building up of the kingdom and the Church.

When we realize these principles, then we know that a certain percentage of our income is to be given away. The TITHE is how believers calculate that amount. One tenth of my income is to be returned to the Lord – through taking care of His Church, and other charities of our choice. The amazing thing is that what we give back to the Lord, who lets us keep the other 90%, always comes back to us in large and small ways. In other words, what we give away, is invested in God's work and we receive spiritual blessings as well as material blessings. That is why you will never meet an "EX-TITHER". For we know that our God cannot be outdone in generosity.

We become generous to the extent that we are grateful for all our blessings. The greater thanks, the greater giving. It is the way of the Lord, who reminds us even in these tight economic times, "To whom much is given, much will be required."

Next weekend, we celebrate COMMITMENT SUNDAY...you will receive a commitment card to fill out your return to the Lord for the coming year. If your income has gone up, so should your commitment. If it has gone down, so should your tithe. Talk it over in your family and decide what return you will make to the Lord for all He had given you, and act accordingly.

Thank you for the commitment you make to be a faithful steward and may you know enriched blessings because you put the Lord first in your checkbook each month. You will not be disappointed.
