PASTOR POTPOURRI — SIMPLICITY AND INTEGRITY

When the late Oscar Romero was appointed the archbishop of San Salvador, prominent wealthy families who controlled most of the land and money in El Salvador offered to build him a palace where he could live splendidly and security. But he chose to live simply, making his home in the sacristy adjacent to the hospital chapel where he served. Because there was not gap between the Gospel he preached and the Gospel he lived, Romero's life – like the life of Jesus – continues to teach the integrity to which every disciple of Jesus is to aspire.

And how is your spirituality going? I would like to suggest that one of the simple ways to help your spiritual health, also helps your physical health. WALKING. It is almost a complete introductory course to a wholistic spirituality. Taking a walk is a friendly way to take the true measure of things. A sense of proportion and perspective seems to return. We are able to get our feet back on the ground. Truth comes to meet us in new ways. And a daily walk or hike is a regular lesson in old fashioned virtues like patience, steadfast resolve and the almost priceless ability to be contentedly unhurried.

Walking seems to heighten consciousness. You feel more creative, with an enlarged sense of possibilities. You don't even have to mull over a problem deliberately. Just think about what comes to mind, enjoy the passing view or worry about something else.

Walking does not require any special equipment, other than some good shoes, and is as natural to the human body as breathing. Let's get back into that habit and see how much better we feel and how much more alive we can become. See you on the path! (Excerpts from CELEBRATION, October 2011)

Don't you love people who do wonderful, holy things every day, out of the sight of the rest of us? Every once in awhile we might accidentally catch them doing good, and I think it's important that we do. How else can we be edified and inspired if we never know that they are companioning an elderly neighbor through his last months in hospice, or loving and comforting a mentally ill spouse, or singing and dancing with a beautiful child backstage for four hours before she walks down the runway with Ed McCaffrey in the Down Syndrome Fashion Show?

There's really no other possible explanation for the heroic things that average people do every day except for this: they are in love. They have let themselves fall deeply in love with Love, and out of that collision has come hospitals, schools, shelters, food banks, foundations, and the spouse who, less than a year after her own mother's long goodbye, now helps care for her husband's mother as she begins that same journey.

Parents are the most inspiring example I can think of, especially those with children who are, how to say this, challenging? Love is patient and kind, believes all things and hopes all things. Is there anything more beautiful than a parent who believes and hopes and loves his child through the awkwardness of adolescence?

Let's take a second to just let all that goodness pour over us and into us and out from us. It's hard to be inspired by the Pharisees, who put their good works on display. How sad. Because our true measure is who we are when no one's looking.

What example can you give of someone who is heroic in silent, small ways?
